**Policy:** Where a person believes they have observed improper conduct by NT Build or an employee working for NT Build and he or she do not want to make an internal report, the person may make a protected disclosure under the provisions of the *Public Interest Disclosure Act* (PID Act) by contacting:

- The Office of the Commissioner for Public Interest Disclosure; or
- The NT Build Registrar as the 'responsible Chief Executive' under the provisions of the PID Act.

Given the size of NT Build, there are likely to be practical constraints on the handling of any disclosures made direct to the NT Build Registrar.

For this reason, any person who wishes to make a protected disclosure concerning NT Build is recommended to do so directly to the Public Interest Disclosure Commissioner.
